History

In December 1969 a group of historians organized the Coordinating Committee of Women Historians in the Profession (CCWHP). Their goals were to recruit women into the historical profession, to alleviate discrimination against women students and faculty, to secure greater inclusion of women in annual meetings and the committees of the American Historical Association, and to encourage the research in and teaching of women's history.

The CCWHP soon became an affiliated organization of the AHA. Reflecting the emerging scholarship on women in history, the Conference Group on Women's History (CGWH) was created in 1974. Since the CGWH remained closely associated with the CCWHP, in 1995 the membership voted to combine the two groups under the name of the Coordinating Council on Women in History (CCWH).

The CCWH is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. All donations to the CCWH are tax-deductible.

What is the CCWH?

The CCWH is a volunteer, non-profit organization dedicated to supporting women historians at all stages of their career and to promoting women's history in all its forms. The CCWH is a vibrant community of women and men who are committed to creating a place where women historians can find a wide variety of resources, support, and a community to help them thrive.
